DIRECTIONS FOR USE

As a laundry additive to kill bed bugs, fleas, mites and ticks, add 1-2 capfuls of solution {or product name} to your normal laundry detergent when washing clothes, bedding, sheets, etc. Use the hottest water possible as appropriate for the fabrics being washed and dry normally, adding an extra 30 minutes using the "High" setting, if possible. After washing/drying, store clean articles only in places that have been thoroughly cleaned, vacuumed and treated with an insecticidal product labeled to kill bed bugs, fleas, mites and ticks [such as {provide a product name}].
